What We Are

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Reading: Students have been introduced to eenters by discussing center rules and practicing working in a small group. We have also launched our new reading program by discovering what good readers do and the parts of a book!

Language Arts: This week students were introduced to listening, speaking, viewing and writing as traits of a good student. We also began identifying complete sentences.

Writing: Students began the writing process while writing about their Grandparents.

Math: Students discussed the concept of joining, in preparation for addition. Students also identified the parts of an addition sentence as addends, plus sign, equal sign and sum.
